Sponsorship Activities

Certain sponsorship levels can choose to be the headlining sponsor for a sponsored activity. Additionally, any of these sponsored activities may be negotiated as an add-on to an existing tier, whether it includes a sponsored activity or not.

All sponsored activities must be combined with a sponsorship tier, i.e. they cannot be chosen independently from regular sponsorship.





Sponsorship Activities

Meal/Beverage sponsor \$2,500 USD	Sponsor a lunch or refreshments break. Lunch and refreshments (e.g. coffee, tea, water) are offered daily at different intervals of the conference. For every \$2,500 sponsored, your organization will be acknowledged with your name and logo for one lunch or refreshment break.	
A/V sponsor (A/V) \$3,500 USD	Sponsor our A/V equipment, service costs, and streaming overhead. A company or project logo can be featured on a splash screen in the session recording after the conference ends (e.g. on YouTube / PeerTube / et al).	
DEI Fund \$1,000 USD Single, \$1000. Double Dip, \$2000. Triple Play, \$3000.	Contribute to a special reserve funding for helping underrepresented minorities and socio-economically challenged attendees make it to the conference. This fund is only used for travel, accommodation, and visa costs.	
Community Social \$3,500 USD	We have done networking dinners, game nights, walking tours, and other fun local activities during the conference. A sponsor can be attributed and thanked for one of these conference-wide evening community social activities.
